First Kidney-Pancreas Transplant at St. Joseph Hospital

Congratulations to Robert M. Naraghi, MD, and Ervin P. Ruzics, MD, transplant surgeons, Yasir A. Qazi, MD, transplant nephrologist, and all physicians and caregivers participating in the first kidney-pancreas transplant performed at St. Joseph Hospital. The dual surgery has been a long-time coming for the team at our Kidney Transplant Center.

Dual kidney-pancreas surgery is life-changing for patients. After surgery, patients no longer require daily insulin or dialysis, bringing them greater freedom after years of medication and dietary restrictions. This surgery makes us a multi-organ transplant hospital; the true benefit is to our patients, who will now have access to more comprehensive transplant care. Earlier this year the Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR) ranked the St. Joseph Hospital Kidney Transplant Center #1 in California for transplant rate and post-transplant survival rate for the second time in a row. This rating, along with their latest achievement, is a testament to the expertise, drive and values of the entire transplant team.
